# REQUEST FOR QUOTE (RFQ)

## I. PURPOSE:

The District is seeking a qualified, licensed and insured contractor to extend the concrete on the existing apparatus driveway between the existing concrete and 76<sup>th</sup> Street North on the south side of Station 3, as identified in the Scope of Work. The remainder of this document provides additional information that will allow a bidder to understand the scope of effort and develop a quote.

## II. SCOPE OF WORK

### A. Excavate:

- a. Grade and compact area for proper drainage. Remove railroad ties and place them in a designated area on the north side of Station 3 lot. Replace or clean out drainage pipe at the entrance (76<sup>th</sup> St North) to the best of vendor's ability for fully-functional, proper drainage at the street

### B. Concrete Work

- a. The project area is located on the south side of Station 3 and is defined as that portion of the existing driveway that is currently topped with gravel, extending south from the existing concrete driveway to 76<sup>th</sup> Street North.
- b. Tie-in with 76<sup>th</sup> Street North shall comply with all State and County requirements.
- c. Supply and forms to Grade. Supply, pour and finish 6" of ODOT Class A 3500 psi. paving concrete with ODOT approved rock and Fibermesh. Saw cut with a Soffcut saw per ACI standards and apply an ODOT approved cure and seal.
- d. Supply, pour and finish Pin on Curbs and Returns.

## III. SERVICE, SERVICE AND ANNUAL MAINTENANCE

- A. Bidders will include warranty information on all repairs and services, including the length of the warranty.

## IV. BIDDER RESPONSIBILITY

- A. The bidder is responsible for supplying their own tools, equipment, materials, and supplies.
- B. The bidder is responsible for supplying a current Certificate of Workers' Compensation prior to work commencing.
- C. The bidder is responsible for supplying Plans to the District and to Rogers County for purpose of obtaining all required permits.
- D. The bidder is responsible for obtaining all required permits.
- E. The bidder is responsible for contacting Call OKIE and appropriate utilities for detection of any sub-surface hazards.

- F. The bidder is responsible for clean up of the site after work has been completed.
